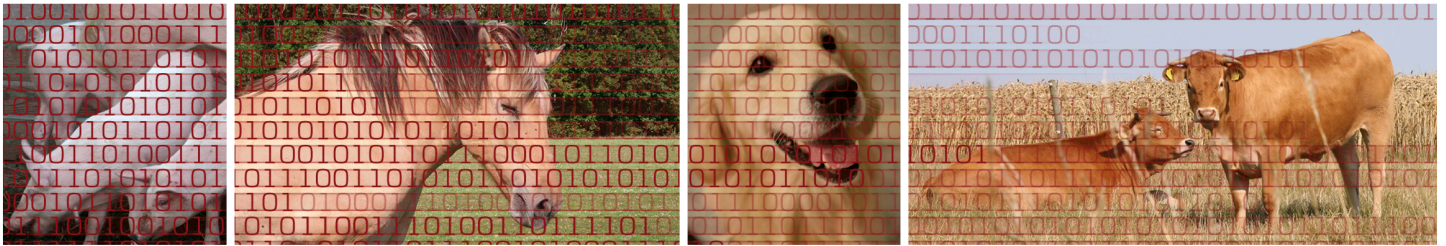




24th NKVet Symposium 19. – 20. April 2010, Copenhagen

DATABASES IN VETERINARY MEDICINE

– Validation, harmonisation and application



The Nordic Committee for Veterinary Scientific Cooperation (Nordisk Komité for Veterinærvidenskabelig samarbeid – NKVet) invites you to take part in this unique event bringing together scientists, practitioners and others interested in databases in Veterinary Medicine. The objective with the Symposium is to provide an overview of the most important databases on animal diseases in the Nordic countries.

What should you expect at this event?

The Symposium sessions will focus on the possibility of using the databases for different purposes such as animal welfare, food safety and animal health economics. Especially, there will be focus on how we, in the future, can make databases more transparent, by establishing database protocols to share among users of the databases. Finally, the possibilities of harmonisation of databases will be presented.

Plenary sessions will focus on the issues:

- Principles of database organisation, data control and establishment of database protocols.
- Presentation and use of the most important databases on animal diseases in the Nordic countries and examples of application.
- Use of databases for assessing animal welfare, food safety and production economy – Opportunities and constraints.
- Database validation – Presentation of a common Nordic project of validation of cattle data bases.
- Recommendations.

In addition workshops will provide the opportunity to exchange knowledge and best practices on some of the issues.

The participants of the Symposium are encouraged to present posters within related issues. Some oral poster presentations will be included in the program.
